#### **Sun 13<sup>th</sup> May - Avon Cycleway part 3 of 4**

Avon Cycleway in 4 parts

The Avon Cycleway is a circular 85 mile route; it does not enter Bristol. I have broken it into 4 parts and for each part we will have to cycle out of Bristol to connect with it, cycle a section, and then cycle back into the city.

Starting from MS at 9.30 am, out on Portway to Shirehampton. If you prefer to wait at Shirehampton, be at the Park & Ride on Portway (almost under the M5 bridge) 50 minutes later.

Bring your own picnic lunch. About 2 pm we will reach a cafe. This is the only place to purchase food on the route so you will definitely need your own supplies prior to this. From Tytherington we will leave the Avon Cycleway to return to Bristol via the Concorde Way.
